Thank you for leading 1<sup>st</sup> word during Lent 2020! We will be reading through the book of Mark in Lent in confirmation. Please see the information below for the day you are leading.

Plan to write at least 2 paragraphs (6-8 sentences) when it is your turn to lead. Potential things to include:

- 1) What do you think the main point (or two) were in the reading?
- 2) How does this reading apply to your life?
  - a. What questions do you have about the reading?
  - b. What do you wish you could ask Jesus?
  - c. Does the text give you direction?
  - d. Does the text cause you to stop and ask questions?
  - e. Does the text give you insight to anything going on in your life?
  - f. Have you ever experienced anything that helps you relate to the text?
- 3) How are you being called to live your life during this season of Lent?

**February 26<sup>th</sup>** 1<sup>st</sup> Word – Mark 1:2-5, 7-13 (Baptism & tempting of Jesus)

**March 4<sup>th</sup>** 1<sup>st</sup> Word – Mark 2:1-12 (Healing paralyzed man)

**March 11<sup>th</sup>** 1<sup>st</sup> Word – Mark 6:45-52 (Jesus walks on water)

**March 18<sup>th</sup>** 1<sup>st</sup> Word – Mark 9:30-37 (Jesus predicts his death & great debate)
