# **Committee Reports:**

#### Secretary's Report – Karen Travis

- Approved March Church Council meeting minutes with the following corrections under Social Concerns:
  - o Should be Southwest Grief Coalition
  - o Should be Cari Larsen (not Karen Larson)
  - o First bullet in social concerns, clarify this is concerning Amextra

# Financial Secretary's Report – Rick Harrison (Handout A)

- March giving was \$2,300 less than last year and below budget expectations. Year-to-date we are still ahead, due to a large contribution in January.
- March attendance was 240 fewer than last year. However, there were more Lenten services in April. Without the Lenten services, attendance was nearly the same.
- Contributions of stock are sold immediately upon donation at market price and counted as cash. Immanuel's policy is that we do not hold on to stock. Items of personal property can be given as gifts as tax-deductible donations, but cannot be counted toward a pledge.

#### Treasurer's Report - Brian Nichols (Handout B)

- Giving is \$17,122 over plan year-to-date.
- Expenses are on plan.
- Program expenses are lower than plan.
- Building fund contributions for March were \$18,000.
- Mortgage Update:
  - We were able to lock in at a rate of 4.75%.
  - Process should be completed in the next 30 o 45 days.
  - Going to a 10-year mortgage, which will lower our monthly payment from \$16,000 to \$11,000.
- A suggestion was made to use available funds to once again pre-fund Camp Onomia this year. Bill will check on this with Kim and Martin Rathjen.

# Vice President's Report - Lee Prinkkila

- Church Lady Program:
  - Lee spoke with the Community Extension Service and gathered information, including a checklist for maintenance, food safety, etc.
  - Learned that non-profit organizations that use our kitchen facilities need to go through their own training program, though we can guide them and they can use our checklist.
  - Plan to get a committee together to do training, using videos and other resources that are available available. Will work with Fellowship to set up a meeting and share the checklist. Details to follow.

### **Evangelism Committee – Mike Berdahl**

- Parking wasn't an issue during Easter services, thanks to the planning that was done. It was helpful to close the exit closest to Eden Prairie Road.
- The Evangelism Committee is looking for more members. Will add an announcement to the Gold Grow sheets.

#### Adult Faith Formation - Lorraine Maenke

- Carol Swanson is winding up the year with the adult bible studies class.
- Confirmed there are now two softball teams.
- A women's retreat is being planned next February at Mount Olivet
- Need to get more people signed up for the upcoming grand parenting/aunting/uncling event, April 21, from 8:30 a.m. to noon. Speaker is Marilyn Sharp, who will be talking about ways to pass along your faith to children who are important to your life. Cost is \$10 per person of \$15 per couple.

# Worship, Music and Arts - Chip Carlson

- Choirs are wrapping things up. Children's choirs will be done for the season by May 9.
   Reformation Choir has three more weeks to sing. Gary is organizing a subset of Reformation Choirs to sing over the summer.
- Discussed the events on Palm Sunday (ambulances were called) and agreed it was well handled.

- Still evaluating steam cleaners.
- The stained glass project is under way.
- Spring clean up day was planned for May 19, but there is a wedding that weekend so
  there may not be a specific day. The group discussed approaching specific groups to
  see if they want to help (e.g., confirmation groups, faith groups). MaryKay has a
  distribution list of faith group leaders (meeting scheduled April 24). In addition, Girl
  Scout groups do clean up day on Earth Day (April 22), and may be looking for
  opportunities to pitch in.

# **March Income Analysis Summary**

March 2012 giving was less than March 2011 and less than March 2012 budget.

- Number of Sundays in March: 4 in both 2012 and 2011.
- March 2012 attendance w/ Lenten Services: 240 less than 2011 (3,553 vs. 3,793)
- March 2012 attendance w/o Lenten Services: 18 less than 2011 (2,398 vs. 2,416)
- Actual giving 2012 vs. 2011
  - o March giving: \$2,331 (2.8%) less than 2011 (\$80,694 vs. \$83,025)
  - o YTD giving: \$17,122 (7.0%) more than 2011 (\$262,456 vs. \$245,333)
- Actual giving vs. budget:
  - o March: \$13,224 (14.1%) less than budget (\$80,694 vs. \$93,918)
  - o YTD: \$10,372 (4.1%) more than budget
- Completed 25.0% of 2012 budget year with total giving at 24.4% of budget.

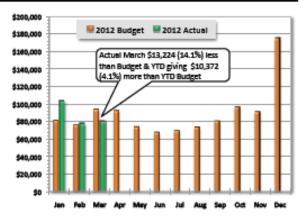
