#### **Committee Reports:**

#### Secretary's Report - Karen Travis

- Janis asked about fees for charitable contributions (Bill's report), and whether the bank fees
  are counted as part of the contribution. Bill's been recording the fee as a church expense
  and not as part of the donation (as explained on the website). Further discussion and
  clarification is needed. Brian and John will work with Bill on this to account for the full
  amount. The parenthetical ("as fees are not counted as charitable donations) will be
  removed.
- John U. motioned to approve June minutes. Brenda T. seconded. Motion carried.

#### Treasurer's Report - Brian Nichols

- Discussed financial reports. Giving is slightly below plan (falling short in July). Immanuel received a health insurance credit in July that helps offset this shortfall.
- We still have 3 months of mortgage payments in reserve. May consider making an additional principal payment this fall to bring the balance down.

#### President's Update - John Urbanski

- Employee Guidebook has been re-circulated to staff and is being reviewed/revised.
- "Luther's Way" deadline is tomorrow. Council members were encouraged to keep submissions in mind.
- Reviewed the Coordinator of In-Reach and Outreach job description. Considering offering
  this new position to Kim Rathjen (at her previous hourly rate). Money has been set aside for
  a staff position. Reaction from the Council was very positive. Lisa A. motioned to offer the
  position to Kim. Susan G. seconded. Motion carried. John will communicate this to Kim.
- Reviewed same gender marriage conversation plan. Will have a series of three conversation opportunities (three different days/weeks/times) to be held at Immanuel, with facilitated small group discussion and questions. Council members would be there to lead discussions and take notes, and also to make sure all are heard. Respectful listening is key. People can also reach out to Council members to share their thoughts on this. Based on feedback from these sessions, the Council (as representatives of the congregation) will discuss and consider a vote at the December meeting. Asked Council members to consider whether they'd like to be a discussion leader or note taker. Preparation will be provided. Suggestion was made to also gather input at faith groups and share it with Council.

#### **Council Reports:**

#### Evangelism Committee - Mike Berdahl

- Will be getting the Meet and Greet going again. Will focus primarily on staffing greeters at the front entrance (finding volunteers has been challenging for two entryways).
- Will do another ALPHA series. Discussed best days of the week for this, based on church and staff availability.
- Will be ordering Immanuel clothing, with the new logo. Mike will work with MaryKay on this (collecting samples and taking orders).
- The next Metro Area Minnesota Via de Cristo event will be held October 17-20 for men, October 24-27 for women. This will take place at St. Stephens Lutheran Church in West St. Paul.

#### Adult Faith Formation - Lorraine Maenke

• No report.

#### Worship, Music and Arts - Janis Cameron

- Choirs are starting up the end of August, with an off-site September 4.
- Roselyn Weber is taking on the Epiphany Choir, and Nicki is finding someone to lead Servant Song until the end of November. Nicki will lead Reformation Choir.
- Looking at transitioning the vendor for flowers.
- 250 new bibles were ordered.
- At the 9:15 a.m. service, they're going to try using chimes as a call to worship, to get people into the sanctuary on time.
- Discussing the possibility of doing a liturgical dance at Everybody Worship service.
- Norwegian professional singers are coming, September 29-October 5, and are looking for homes to stay in while they're here. They'll perform at a service, and a concert in the afternoon.
- Pastor Paul provided an update on Gary. He very much appreciates everyone's prayers and support. Pastor Paul and Martin will send an email to update the congregation. Updated the Council on how this affects Immanuel's budget.

### Properties - Brian Heinzen

- Immanuel's roof is leaking, and we're working on a bid for repair.
- · Will be meeting soon to plan fall projects.
- Met with Prairie Lutheran Church about the security system they put in place. Shared information and may also possibly share resources. Looking at putting together a security task force to address security (an increasing concern among churches nationwide).

# Senior High and Middle School Youth – Brenda Tonjes and Kirsten Stenoien; Shannon Fleck and Mary Hovet

- Will be using a different book for fundraising, available in a phone app or a coupon book.
   Immanuel gets half the cost of the book to support fundraising.
- Pool parties are coming up this weekend (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade)
- Lock-in will be end of September. Looking at new locations this year.
- Talking about a possible college student mission trip next summer
- Next year's mission trip will be in Denver, Colorado.

#### Stewardship - Paul Stordahl

• Planning kickoff for the fall stewardship campaign.

#### Children's Education - Lisa Anderson and Eldri Johnson

- Great to have Tracy on board. Started talking about the budget and whether we can use the Sunday school offering balance to sponsor someone through Compassion International.
- Came out ahead by \$800 with VBS this year. Got 145 registered and 82 volunteers.
   Discussed opportunities for improvement next year. Looking at different types of programing for VBS for next year. Survey was positive, with more than 95% rating it "very good" or "excellent," and 100% for friendliness of the staff.
- Talked about Sunday school (9:15 a.m. and 10:45 a.m.). Expect a push toward the end of the year for registrations. Adding a parent/child class at the 10:45 service. Talked about the curriculum for Sunday school, and how to get kids more involved in the Everybody Worship service.
- Agreed to continue Families First weekends (first weekend of every month), geared toward the entire family (all ages).

## 2013 July Analysis Summary


July 2013 giving was less than July 2012 and less than July 2013 budget.
