| 1 light-weight bath-size towel, dark color                       | 2-3 bars soap to total 8-9 oz in original wrapping |
| 1 adult-size toothbrush in original packaging                    | 1 sturdy comb, remove packaging                    |
| 1 metal nail clippers (attached file optional), remove packaging |  |
