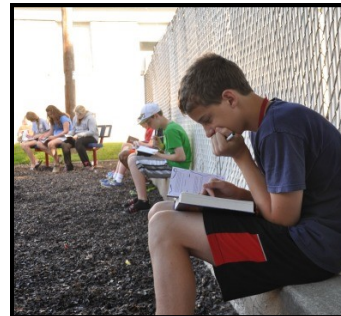

Background

St. Louis lies on the west bank of the Mississippi River (bridged there at several points) opposite East St. Louis, Illinois, just south of the confluence of the Missouri River. The city's boundaries have remained unchanged since 1876. The area was originally inhabited by mound builders of the Mississippian culture. St. Louis is the largest metropolitan area in Missouri. St. Louis reached its peak population in 1950 before "white flight" attributed to 1/2 the city's population, predominantly white residents, moving to the surrounding suburbs. Our group will serve St. Louis in a variety of ways, often crossing racial and geographic lines. We'll also engage in discussions around race and poverty from a Christian mindset. YouthWorks, our mission trip organizer, has partnered with this community since 2002.
