Weddings are wonderful celebrations! Every day across the world, over 45,000 couples are getting married. That's a lot of wedding cake!

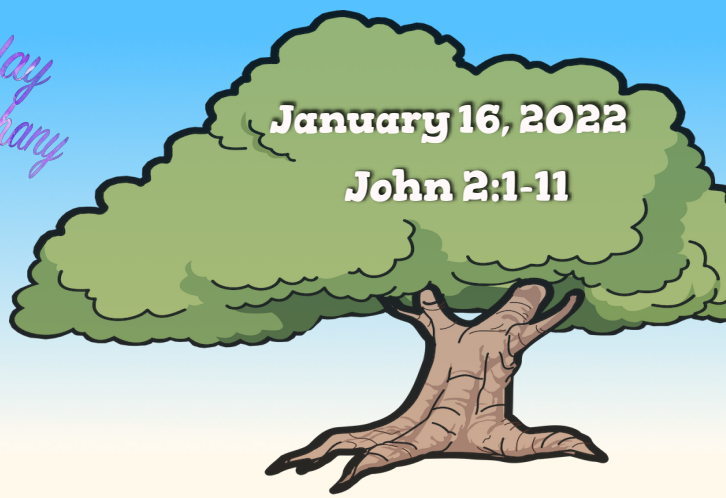


### Color That Stuff

### Wedding

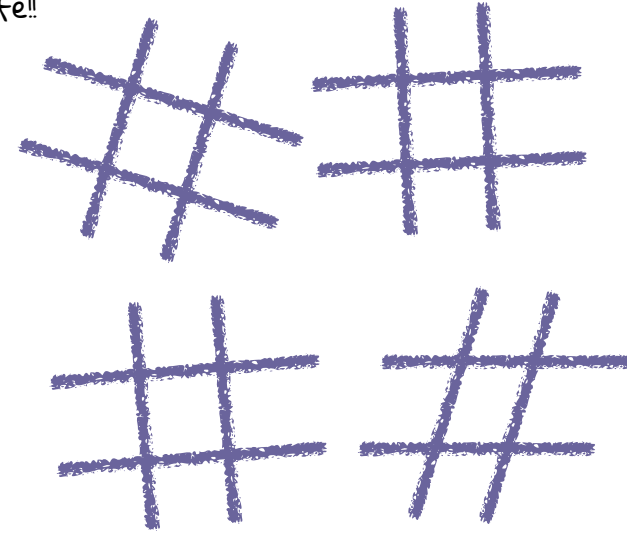
An event when two people commit to love, care, and stay with each other for life.
