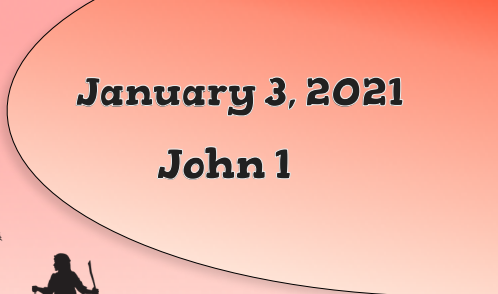

Loving Jesus starts with first knowing that God loves and cares for us, no matter what!

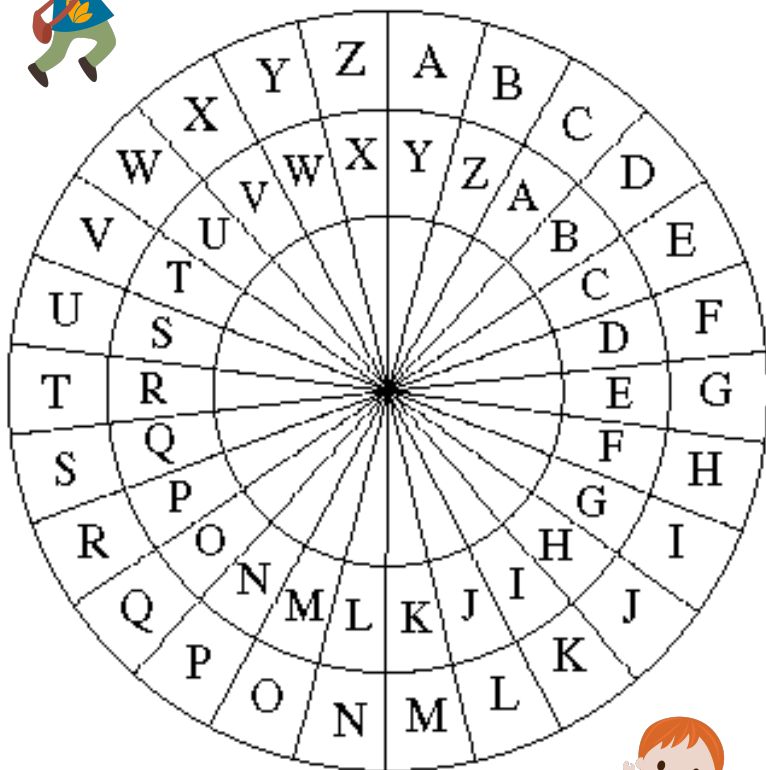

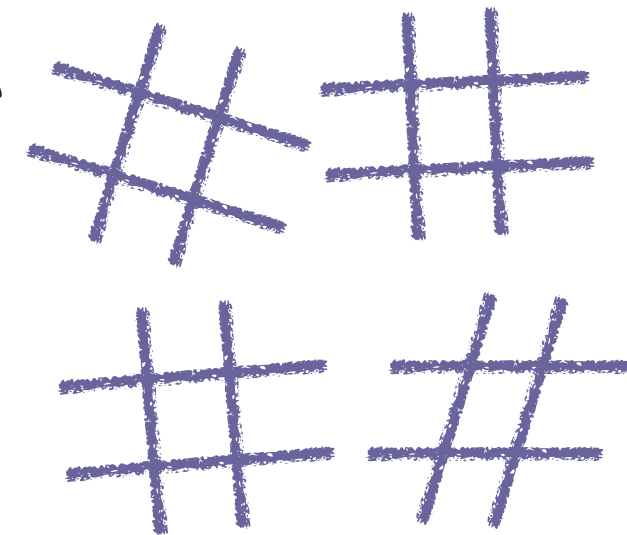
