

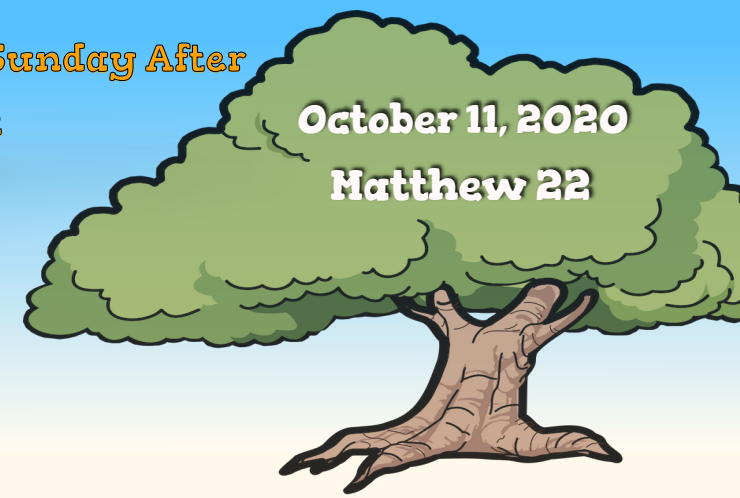


Jesus frequently spoke in parables. They're stories, and often strange – they were like this to make you think!

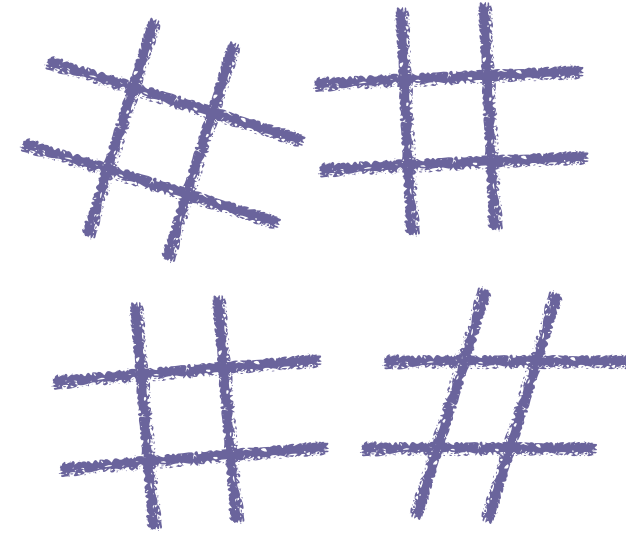
