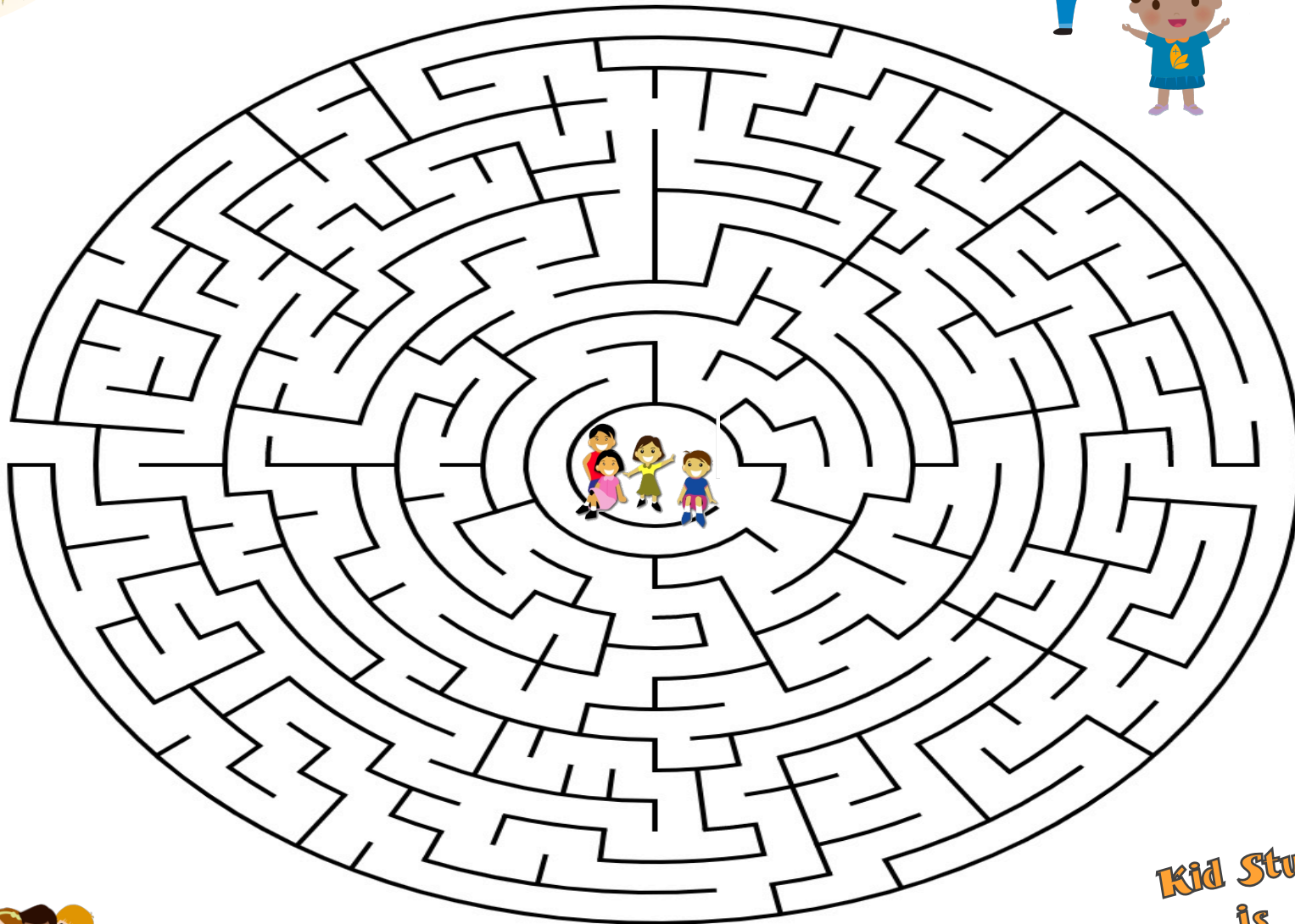
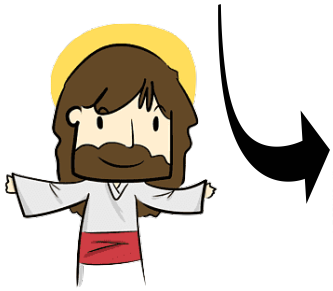

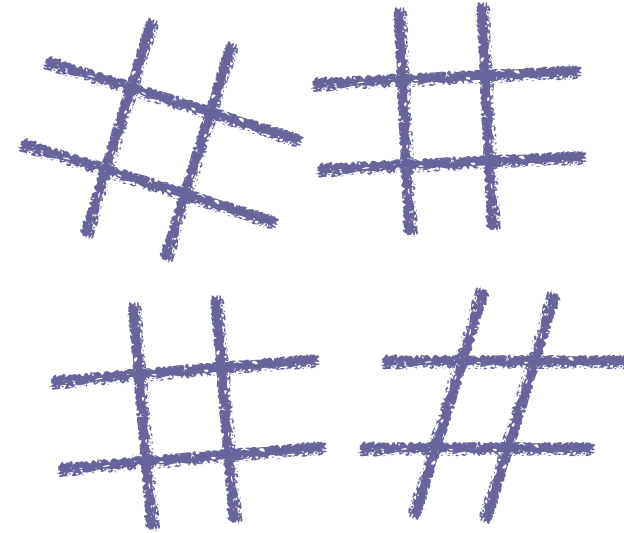



Special Task Force
