Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: Connie made a motion to approve the minutes for September 2023. Mike seconded the motion and all approved.

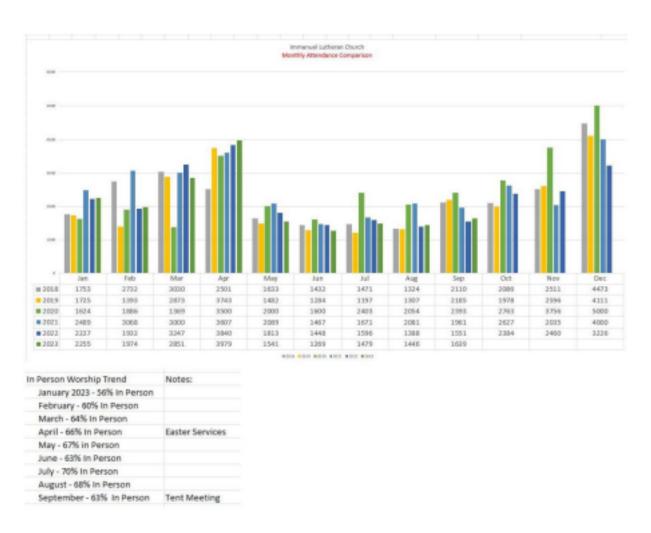

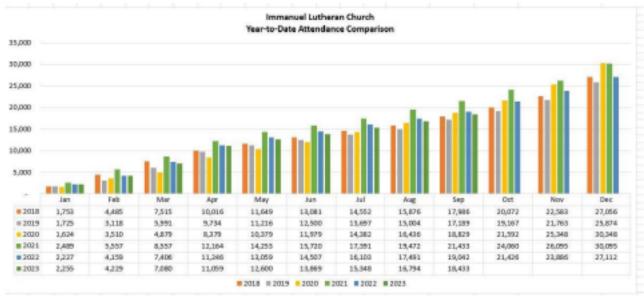
Devotions

2023 budget was not balanced - aligned as a congregation to use \$20K from reserves to fund budget.

Church Administrator update - Kelly

 Funds were approved by Executive Committee for Paul E and Grace to attend the 2024 Youth Extravaganza in Jan 2024, New Orleans. Purpose is to prepare for the July 2024 National Youth Gathering. • Kelly reported estimates of \$47,400 for a 2nd columbarium which does not include the foundation work or work to /around the area. 30-40 weeks for completion. \$49,500 in the account which has been accumulated from people purchasing a niche. There are currently 10 left, but we are behind on engraving so there may be less funds available. Potential to pull from reserves and then we can replenish.

- game night on 9/29 was cancelled and will be rescheduled for a later time (January or February). Confirmation Retreat at Camp Onomia Nov. 10-12. There are 27 people signed up with anticipation of 50 in attendance.
- Youth Rejoice February 25, 2024 and Garage Sale May 4, 2024. We will be doing additional fundraising events for those attending the National Youth Gathering. Hopeful to take the \$1500 cost and have enough funds so that families only have to pay \$700.
- Care packages for college students Kate and Phil will be shopping for goods to go in packages. Phil and Jolene positions are up for elections. Phil is finishing his second term and can't move forward with another

term. Jolene is open to moving forward with a second term.

Children's Ministry – Jenny

- 10:30 Sunday School has about 8-12 kids which has been going well. Need additional volunteers. Talked about annual donations to Camp Wapo and where that money would come from may shift from Children's Ministry budget to Benevolence in 2024.
- Sign up for trunk or treat Oct. 28 last year about 200 people.
- · Grace is planning child advent packages.
- Advent starts a week earlier (Nov. 26 so the 4th week of Advent isn't on Christmas Eve). Sunday after Thanksgiving after the 9 service will focus on decorating for Advent season, with treats and caroling

• Wednesday Café is doing well and they have been coming in or under budget every week. • Smorgasbord planning is well underway. Potential request to serve alcohol. Potential to have drivers for the individuals who do not like to drive at night.

Social Concerns - Kristi

- Benevolence audit committee was requesting who we were donating to and why. Social Concerns committee along with Deacon Savannah will provide more details on requested benevolence for 2024. Need to understand why there is a wide range in benevolence amounts.
- Plan to start adding the ages ranges for volunteer opportunities.
- Almost an okay to re-start the blood drive and looking at December dates.
- Circle of Welcome most of the finances are mostly going to interpreters. Original individuals are moving to be closer to secured employment, working on English and getting their driver's license.
- Coat drive for loaves and fishes collecting through the month of October requesting all Minnesota layers. Humanity Alliance food prep on October 23 and November 17 to deliver food.
- Habitat for Humanity in Prior Lake on Saturday, November 11th.
- Anna's Craft Sale is Sat. Sun., Nov. 4th & 5th.
- November 19 Savannah will be having a community fair in conjunction with Stewardship Sunday.
