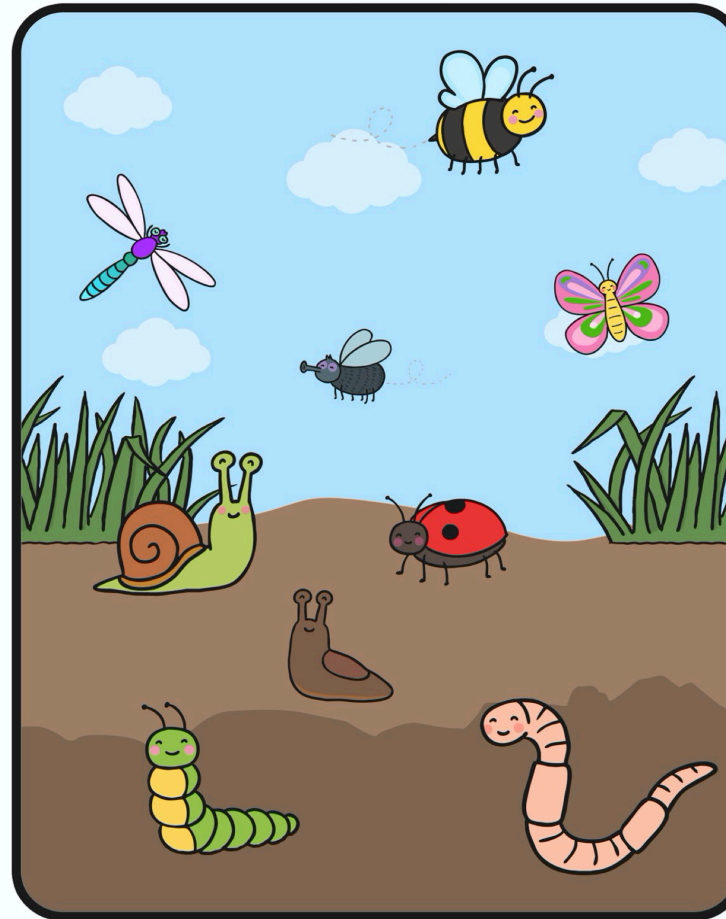
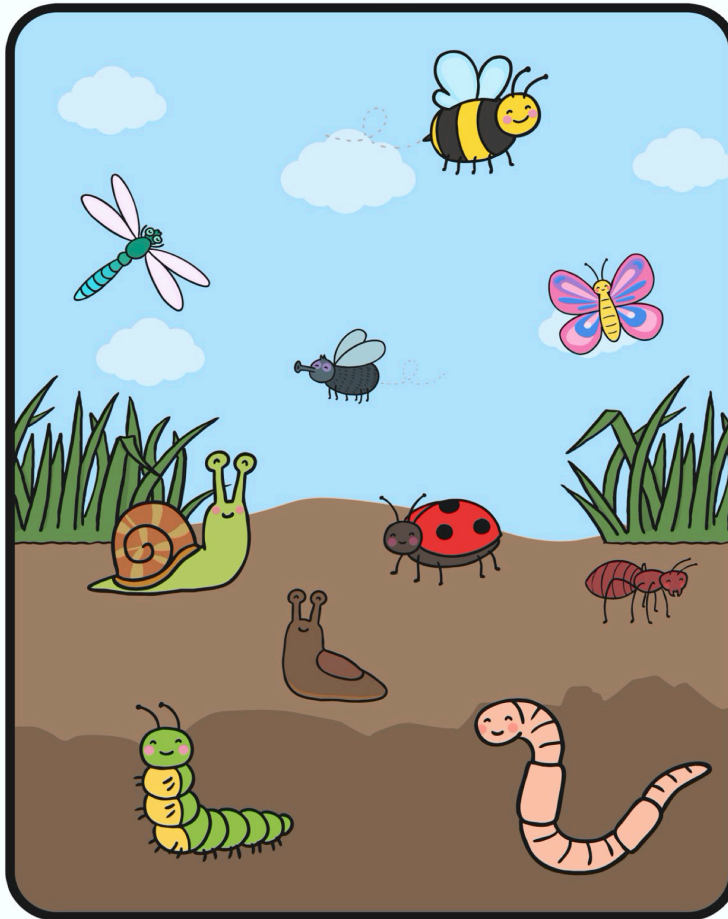

There are 6 differences in the pictures below, can you find them?

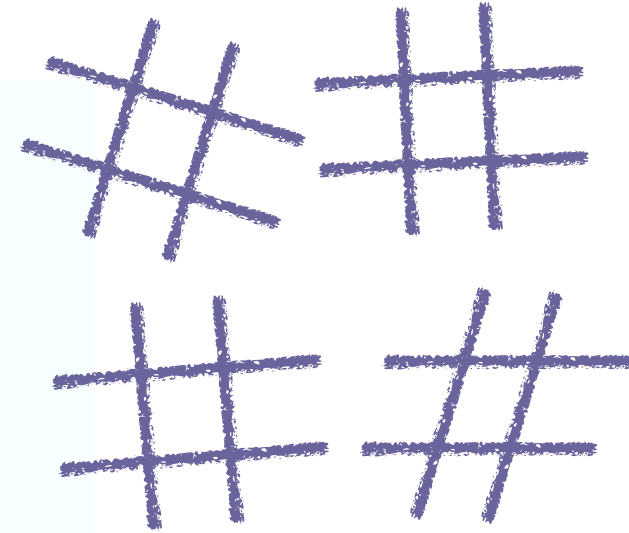


John 3:16
