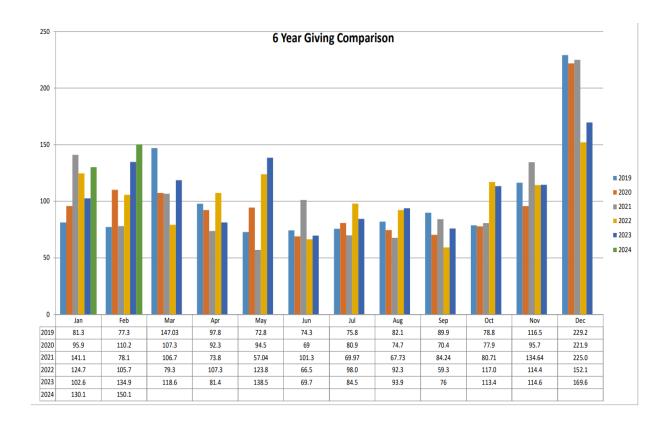
Rick presented the attendance and giving information.

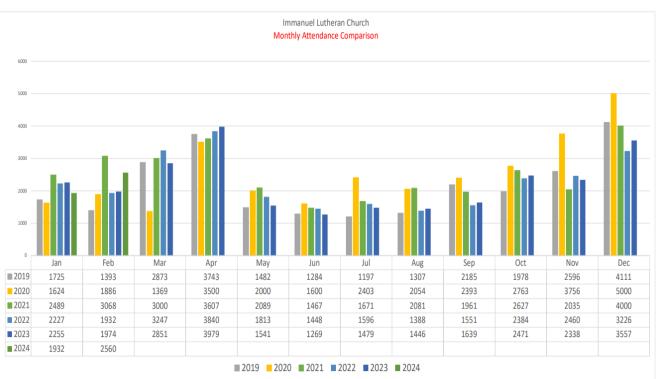
- Feb. stellar month for attendance.

- 37,000 greater than a year ago.

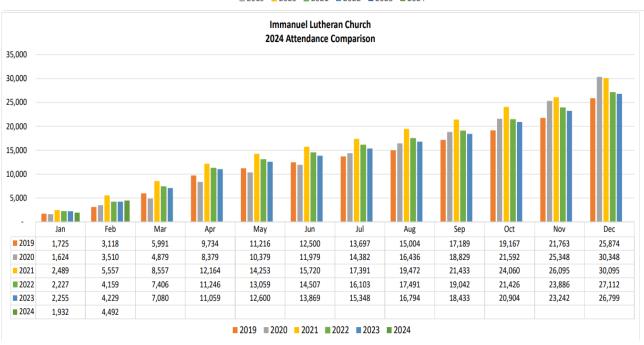
- Giving per week ~ \$33,000

## **HVAC** Replacement

- HVAC replacement will begin on Monday, Mar 18. It is expected to take 1-2 days to complete.
- Some preliminary work began this week.
  - o Replacing window in Deacon Savanah's office
- Window install rescheduled to Apr 5
- Discovered window was cracked when tried to install on Jan 12
  - City of Eden Prairie Backflow Prevention Survey/Audit
- Remediation was completed in February for the six water-related risks identified by the City of Eden Prairie.
- Includes the kitchen dishwasher, baptismal font, and valve for the outside garden hose on the West side of church. A yearly inspection will be required going forward.
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> Columbarium
- After meeting with Pastor Paul, Berry Eichman, Rich Pudas & Mark, we agreed to locate the second columbarium approx. 4 ft from the current columbarium. When facing the church, it will be located on the left side of the current columbarium.
- Two bids were received to install the cement foundation that the columbarium will sit on along with landscaping work (remove/install pavers & remove an existing shrub). We have selected Ron Nemec's landscaping company for this work. He will soon let us know when he is able to get started.
