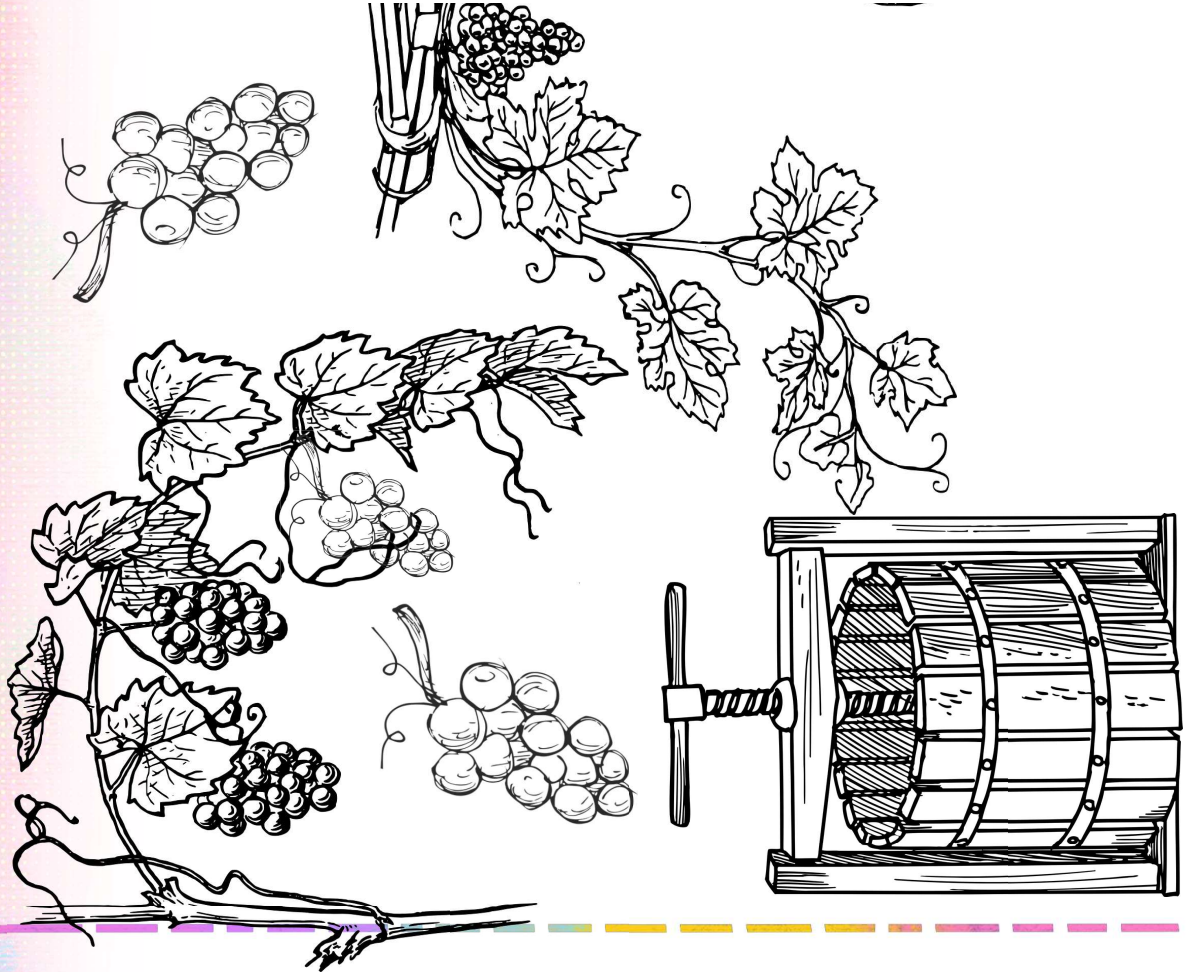

Can you find ten (10) differences between these two vineyard pictures?



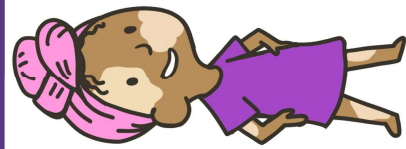
TRY IT AT HOME!
