Each year, over 300 people try to reach the summit of Mount Everest, the world's tallest mountain.

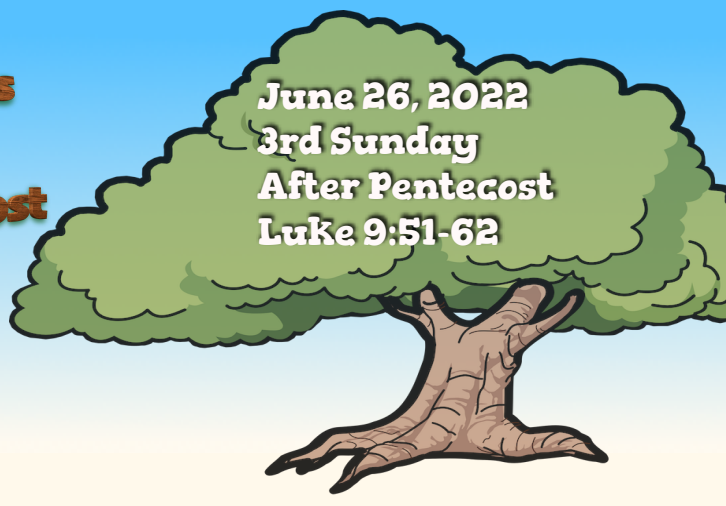

Jesus shook his head. "Sharing God's love with the world has to come first," he said. "It is the most important thing there is."



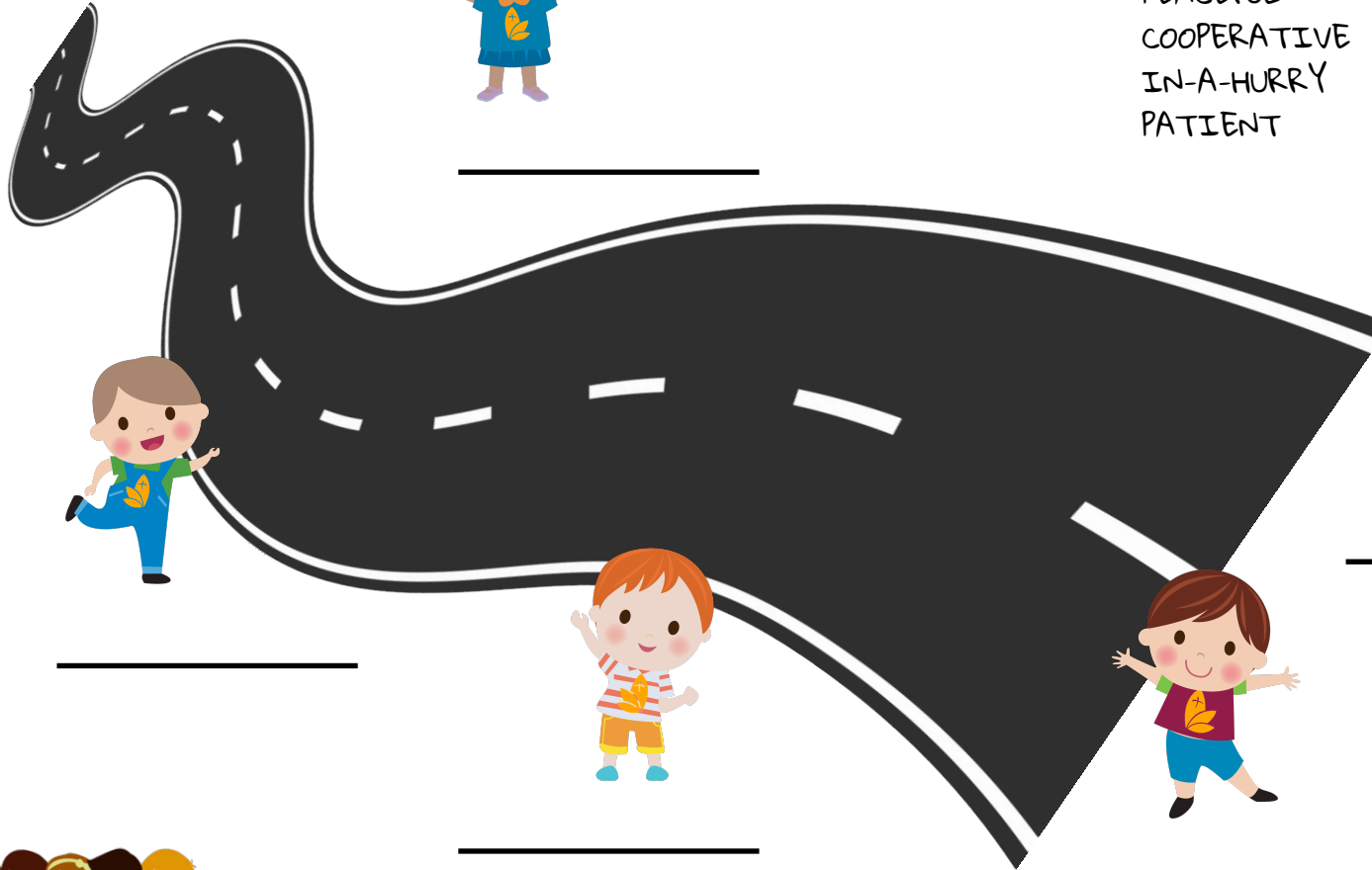

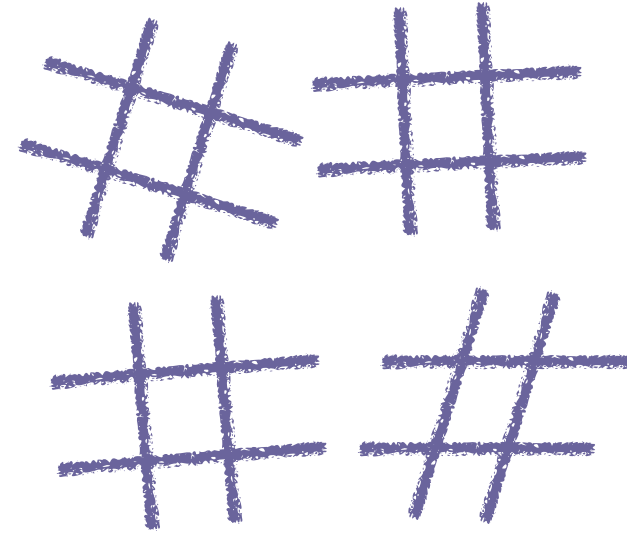
