Even today, when people show generosity and faith, Jesus performs miracles.

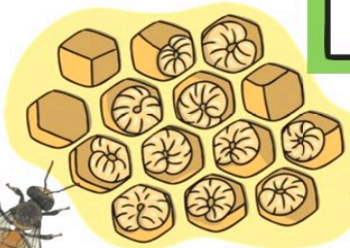
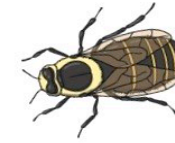
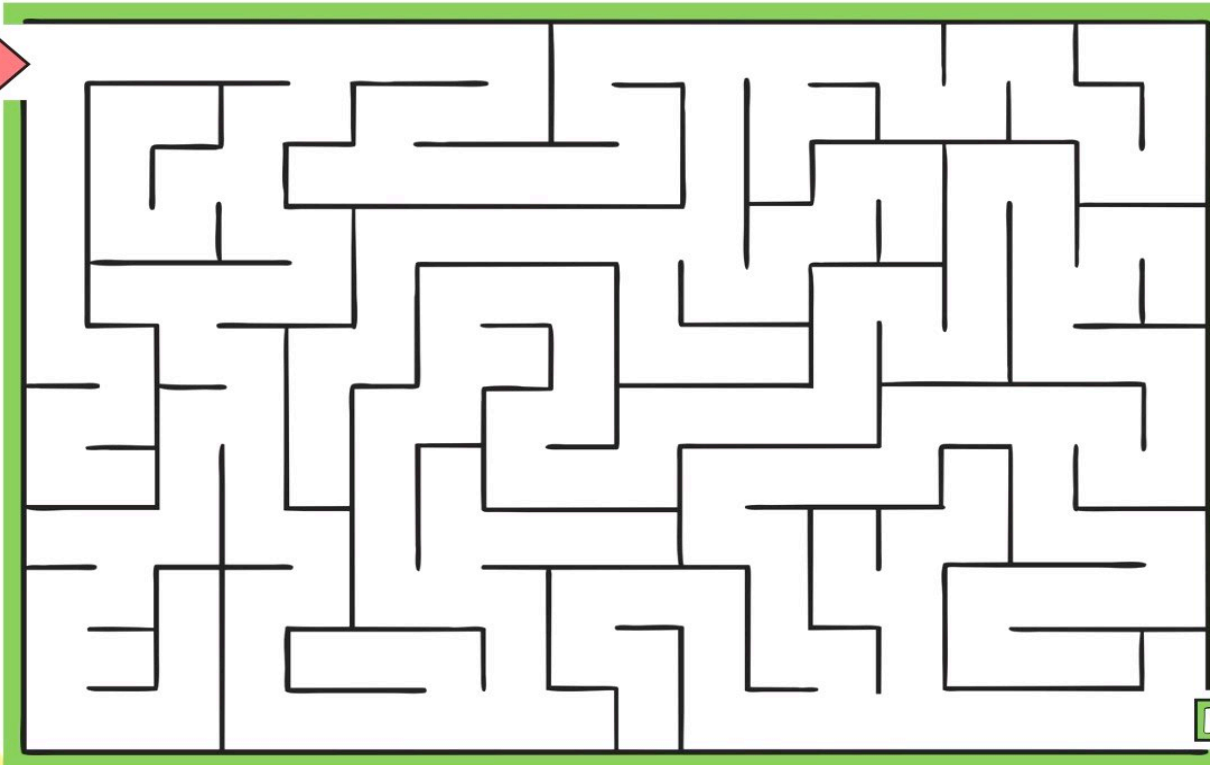

Mmmm. Honey is delicious. But the bees think so, too. Help the bees get through their hive. Careful not to get stung!

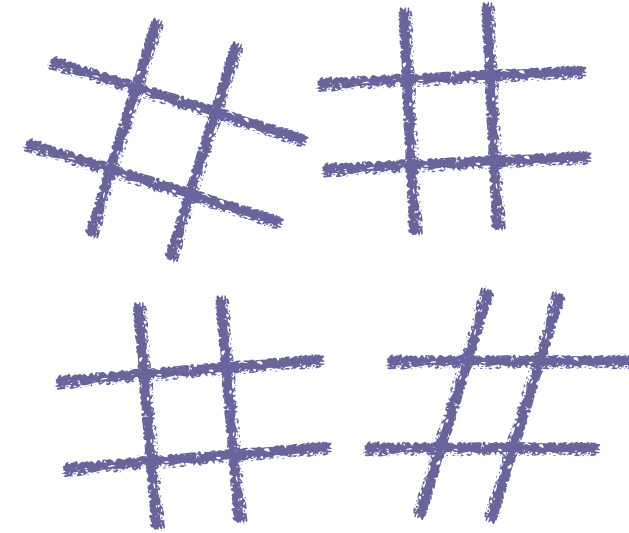


Special Task Force
