Jesus smiled. "You're right! God's power and love are for everyone. So I will help you." At that moment, the woman's daughter was healed.

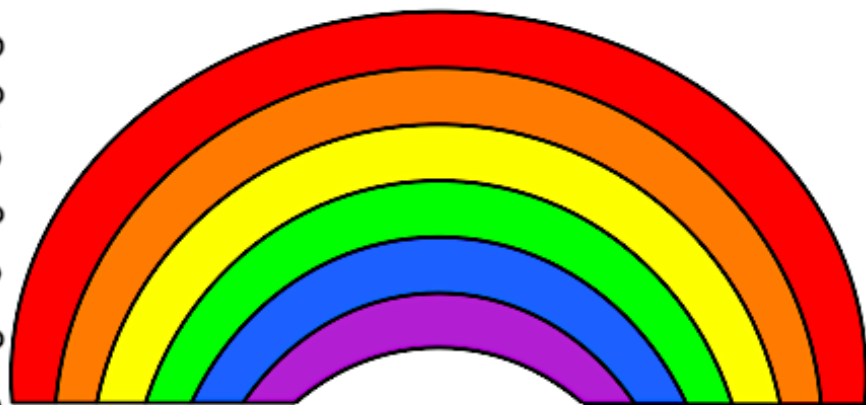
Jesus' friends had learned their lesson. They couldn't keep God's love for themselves. It belonged to everyone, even people who were different from them!

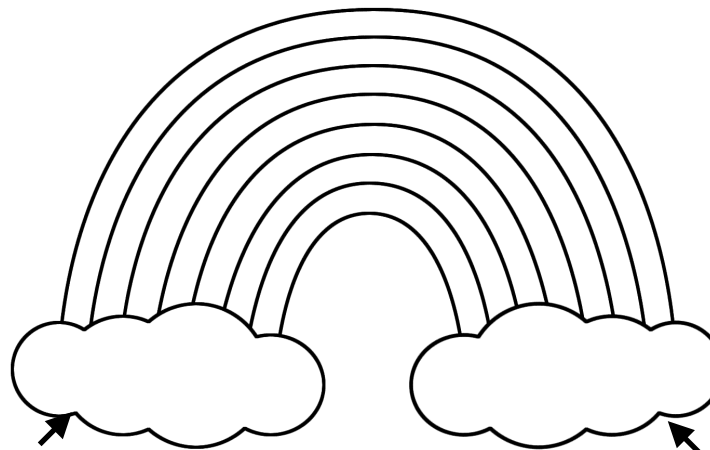

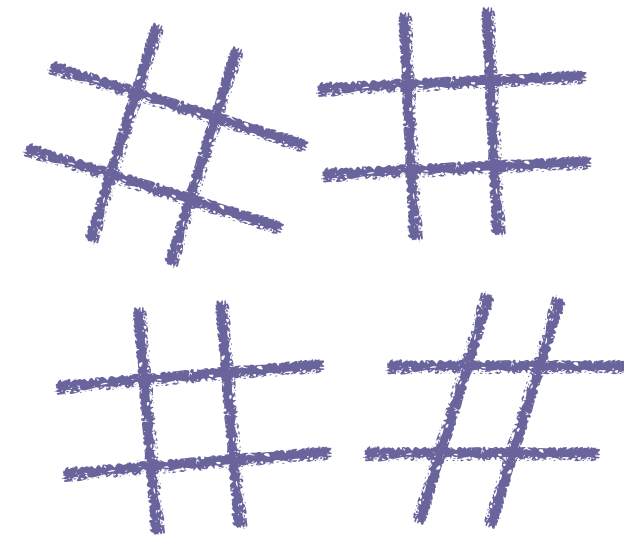
