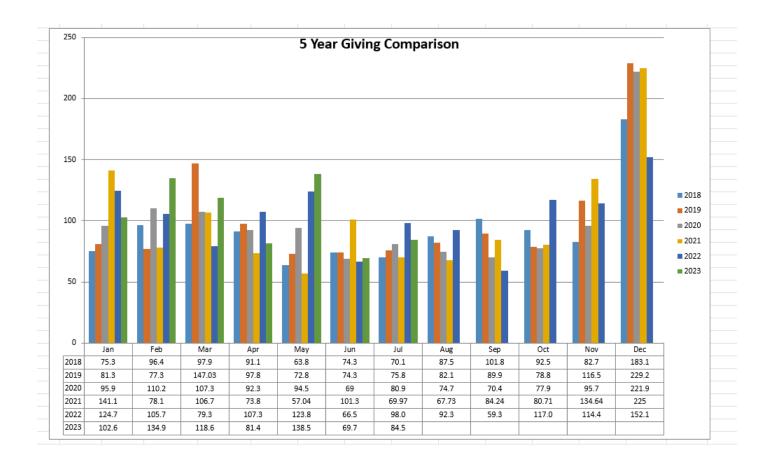

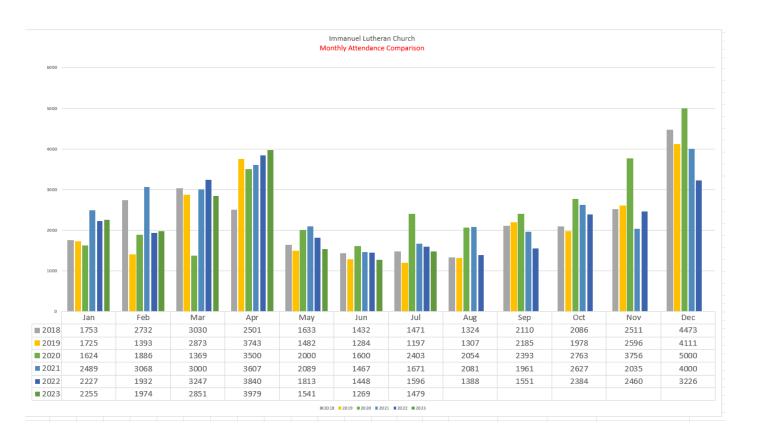

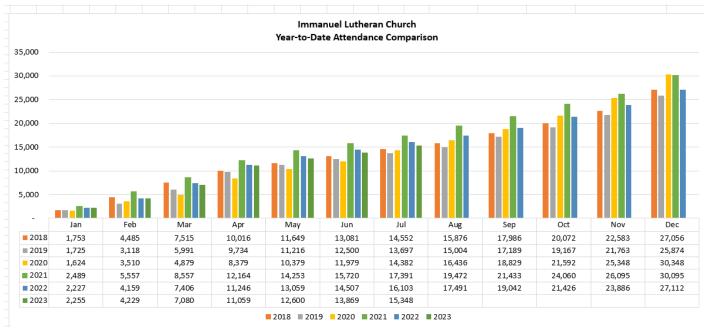

Committee Updates: June and July Updates Middle School – Jolene T/Lisa

- All service-learning trips are done
 - Middle school came back from Superior where they attended Camp Ompathon
 - High school students went to St. Louis in June
 - Discussions underway for high school students to go to New Orleans for ELCA Youth Gathering July 2024
 - Confirmation prep is underway

Properties – Mark A

- Contractor built replacement kitchen cabinet for half the price versus going with original proposal.
- Light bulbs were replaced in the Sanctuary the end of July. Considering contracting bulb replacement in Luther Hall.
- Getting an estimate to move stained glass light boxes from Luther Hall to Fellowship Hall.
- Eagle project decision was to move forward with a pollinator garden and place it by the Disciple's Garden. Plans still need to be reviewed but hope to have this completed this fall.
- Between now and the end of September there will be a few trees removed on the property working with Ron Nemec on project.
- HVAC estimates are much higher than initial. Further discussion will be held regarding overall Raise the Roof
 projects and priorities.
- Maintenance done on holding pond in June.

Senior High - Kate/Phil

- 12 students and 2 adults went to St. Louis in June for their summer service project.
