Jesus said, "Keep following me and you'll see."

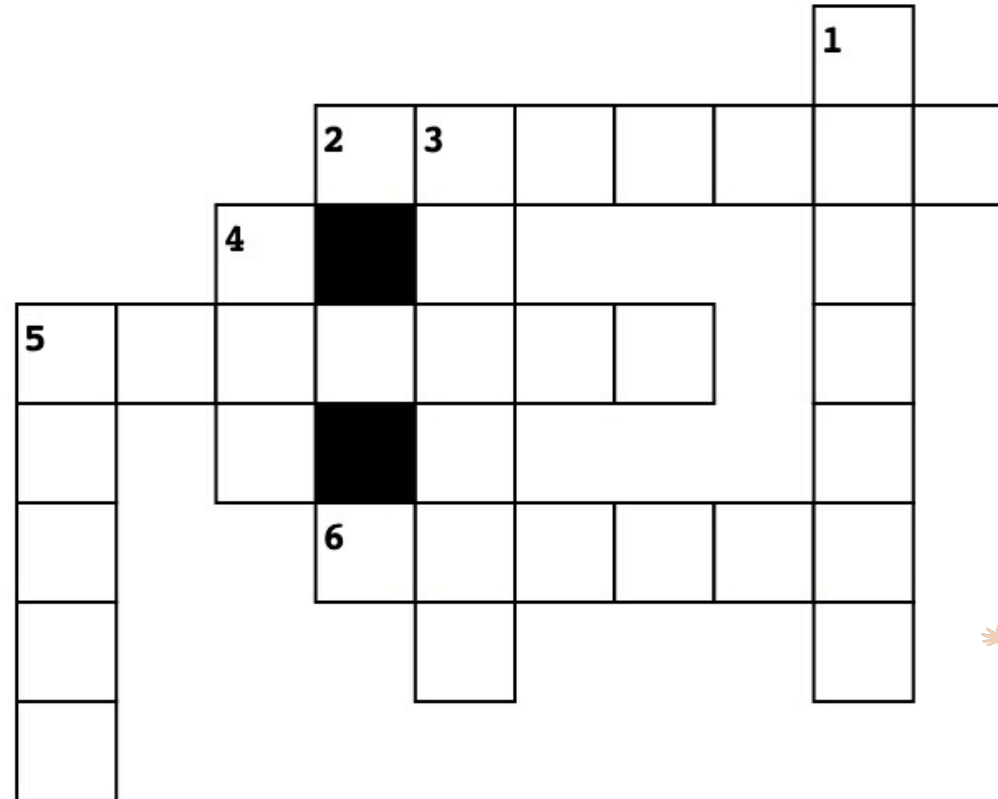

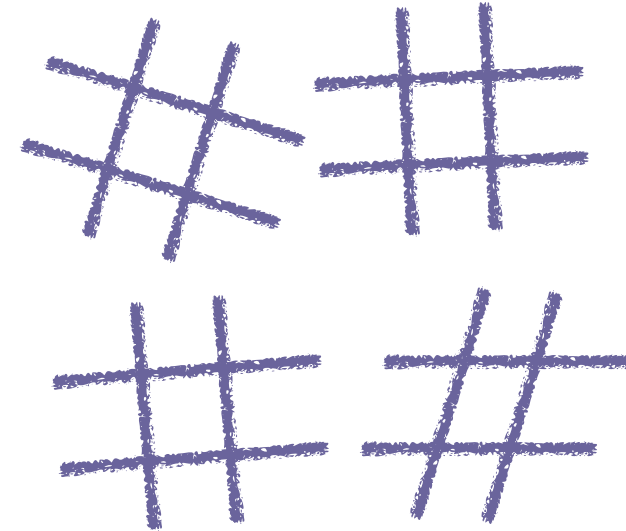
