Ministry update

- 4 funerals in the next two weeks.
- Wonderful tent weekend, bingo raised almost \$3,000 for PROP.
 - Food trucks didn't show up (one forgot, other said they were coming and then said mechanical problems, bought pizzas and sold slices (Angie and Mike).
 - o Grill initially didn't work on Sunday but all volunteers rolled with the punches.
- Everything starts back up tomorrow.
- Bringing back Sunday School at 10:30 am 25 kids signed up.
- Pastor Dan's installation on 9/24 and Pastor Craig Pederson is coming to represent the Synod.
- Unpacking Shaped by God theme this fall.
- Pastor Paul will be leaving for Italy on Oct 9 along with the other trip participants.
- Reviewed calendar through mid-December.

Continued great collaboration of staff, stepping in where needed.

Church Administrator update

- Met with audit committee for a mid-year discussion
 - Question raised about benevolence giving why we choose these ministries; highlighted need to better document rationale and communicate to the congregation as it is one of the biggest sums of money – Savannah evaluating partner ministries
 - Good progress being made, helping identify opportunities
- Updates to website being made, obtaining insights on how to help us be better identified in Google searches, and input on how to organize the site so it is easier to find things should start to see some basic changes with more to come.
- Insurance selection needed.
- Motion made to approve 2024 benefits at Silver A level from Portico Connie made the motion, Jennifer seconded, all voted to approve the motion.
- Rais the Roof formed a committee as result of the August Executive Committee meeting and met to discuss how we are spending Raid the Roof capital funds.
 - Roof sections and roof top HVAC unit next priorities current estimates are approximately \$200,000 for the HVAC unit and \$100,000 for roof sections identified as most critically in need of repair.
 - Horowitz appears to be the best bid when compared across 3 bids received.
 - No down payment required, will bill when onsite
 - \$127,000 in available Raise the Roof funds, at current rate of giving, we should have funds for unit in next 4-5 months (4 month lead time for equipment) but would not have what is needed for roof.
 - Question can we borrow money from reserves and do journal entry, paying the money back to the reserves as it is received from future giving?
 - It was decided to bring the question to Council for broader input (audit committee recommendation)

Middle School – Jolene T/Lisa

Properties - Mark A

- LED bulb replacement in Luther Hall
 - o We will be hiring Premier Lighting to replace all light bulbs in Luther Hall. They're targeting late September to complete this work.
- Tree Removal/Trim
 - Tree removal and trimming has been completed by Ron Nemec's company.
 - 2 dead pines along Luther Way, the pine near the holding pond, a Russian Olive on the west side of the church and trimmed the pine on the west end of the parking lot.
- Raise the Roof Capital Budget

o A group consisting of Kelly, Pastor Paul, Jennifer Schroer, Tom Totall & Mark Arvidson has been created to help guide/manage the Raise the Roof budget and spending.

o Next project will be to replace the two oldest roof sections (4&7) along with the oldest HVAC on section 4

- Three bids have been received for the HVAC replacement so a final decision will be made soon.
- Native Species Pollinator Garden Eagle Scout Project, Clark Heilman
 - o Clark will be moving forward with a new pollinator garden next to the Disciples Garden (east side of garden, south of the garden gate).
 - Install date is scheduled for Sat Sept 30.
- Holding Pond
 - o The second mow/maintenance of the holding pond was completed in August.
 - Mark will follow-up to determine if a 3rd mow will be completed this fall
- Fall Cleanup
 - o Fall cleanup has been scheduled for Sat Oct 28th.

Senior High – Kate/Phil

- Summer wrap-up with youth committee meeting this Sunday.
- Wyoming happened, although smaller group this year. Big summer with Holden Village trip happening also, so that may have played a role.
- Successful trip overall for learning projects in St. Louis this past July.
