Secretary's report: Beth moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Second by Paul S, the motion carried.

Pastor update:

- five baptisms, two funerals and one wedding since the last meeting. The theme for this fall is Everyday Worship. This summer the theme is Life Now, ending with Life each day with God.
- Approximately 130 pledges total \$619,000 for our new Building Up campaign. As of now we have received 94% of the pledges for Opening Doors.
- At this point we have cash on hand of \$215,832. With Building Up pledges of \$619,000, this will result in an available income of \$834,832 anticipated after the three years. When you subtract mortgage payments for three years of \$255,600 and Building Up project costs and donations of \$252,960, we should have cash on hand in May 2022 of approximately \$326,272 and a mortgage balance of \$333,154.
- Backpacking in the Bighorns will include 34 campers. Bingo event is being planned.

President's report: the parish nurse will visit council and talk about her role.

Discussed the absence of both pastors when they traveled to Tanzania, will avoid this situation in the future. Angela and Paul both make home visits. Talked about Angela's role as a half time pastor during the summer, ¾ time the rest of the year. Do we need two full time pastors? This should be addressed by long range planning.
