Use this resource at home to guide your household's daily devotions.



Pray: Light a candle. Open your devotion with prayer.

Resurrected Lord, your disciples were joyful when you returned to them that Easter day. May we—who have not seen, heard, and felt as they have—also know that same joy through the power of your Spirit. Amen.



Read: Read the key verse from Sunday's reading.

Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." (John 20:27)



Reflect: Reflect on the scripture summary.

Thomas was not in the room when Jesus came, spoke, and breathed on his disciples. He wanted more proof than the disciples' word.



Connect: Connect in conversation with others in your household or community.

What was a high point of your day? What was a low point?

Tell of a time you experienced FOMO (Fear of Missing Out).

Would you describe your faith as primarily belief or primarily doubt? (There's no right or wrong answer, here!) Why?

For the littles: Whose is your favorite hand to hold?



Bless: Close your devotion with a blessing.

May God bless your belief and your doubt. Amen.
