Prophetic Voices—Isaiah

- Isaiah is a new initiative to bring people and communities together as people of faith in public life.
 - Seeking to unite 300-350 Minnesota congregations through prophetic preaching; prophetic teaching; faith-to-faith conversations; and candidate forums.
 - Invited Immanuel to publicly support the campaign and participate, and to lead a faith-to-faith initiative (talk with 2,000 people of faith about what issues matter to them and how their values influence their political decisions—part of a candidates forum).
 - Helps people think about how to decide which candidates to vote for based on fundamental values.
 - If we choose to participate, a staff person would be assigned to Immanuel 50% of the time and they would ask to conduct 25-30 one-to-one conversations in the congregation.
 - Isaiah would like an answer from Immanuel by early June (however, Immanuel may need more time to make a determination).
- The Council discussed issues/concerns with regard to participating. The group appears to be divided on the political implications. Additional discussion is planned for the next meeting, after the Council has an opportunity to reflect on this decision.

Secretary's Report - Karen Travis

- Corrections: Page 2 Treasurer's report, change \$12,000 (giving) to \$17,122
- Approved April Church Council meeting minutes, as corrected.

Financial Secretary's Report – Rick Harrison

- Very positive financial report. We are \$26,000 ahead on budget vs. actual; giving is \$31,000 higher than planned (against 2011).
- Added more information on attendance to the income report. Attendance is down from last year. Last year we had and average of 809/week. This year we've had 736/week.

Treasurer's Report - Brian Nichols

- Giving is above plan and expenses are below plan.
- Five for Fifty giving adds \$10,000 in reserve to the month.
- Completed the mortgage refinance to lower the payment to \$15,000 and makes the goal of paying off the mortgage in five years much more attainable.

- Had eight new adult members last Sunday and five children.
- Praise to Mike for the Sunday Greeters program!

Adult Faith Formation – Lorraine Maenke

- The last day of Adult Sunday school with Carol Swanson is May 20.
- Young adult group had a social hour and plans visibility at tent meeting.
- Grandparenting session on how to be an integral part of faith development to the youth of our conversation (26 people attended).
- GROW is finishing up for the season. Theme for next year is "pray."
- At the May 22 meeting the group will start planning for next year.
- Fall event through crossroads will be focused on singles (still working out the details).

Worship, Music and Arts - Chip Carlson

- Met with the committee last night.
- Most of the musical groups are wrapping up for the year and going to summer schedule.
- Epiphany choir had a "bring a friend to choir" event last month.
- Brass group will continue through the summer by popular request from members.
- Looking at how to re-engage high school youth after they get out of youth choir.
- Complaints have been received about the quality of flowers.
 - Thinking about establishing a position of "flower coordinator" who could look at alternatives to the current supplier (e.g., having people contribute flowers from gardens or other vendors).
 - Martin may add a tool to the website to help support this.
 - Might be able to save some money and improve the quality.

- Number of Sundays in April: 5 Sundays 2012 and 4 Sundays 2011.
- Number of Sundays YTD: 18 Sundays 2012 and 17 Sundays 2011.
- April 2012 attendance: 201 less than 2011 (4,415 vs 4,616)*
- Actual giving 2012 vs 2011
 - April giving: \$13,839 (14.6%) more than 2011 (\$108,798 vs \$94,959)
 - YTD giving: \$30,961 (9.1%) more than 2011 (\$371,254 vs \$340,293)

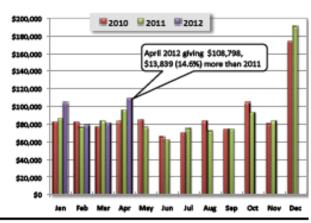

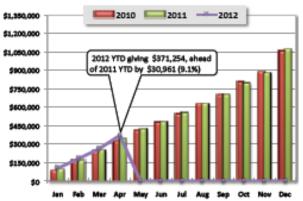

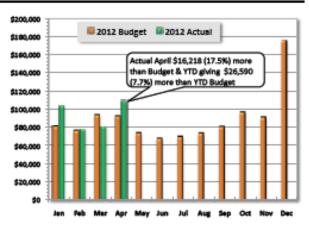
