# Treasurer's report- Brian Nichols

Highlights:

- Giving in March exceeded budget by over 7%. YTD giving is 2% over budget.
- Church expenses were 1.7 % over budget for the month and are 4.7 % over budget YTD.
- Most of the church expense budget variance is related to office supplies (copies).
- Program expenses were under budget for both month and YTD.
- Received \$28,052 for 5 for 50 campaign in March.
