Helps and Hints for Writing a FaithBit

- From your own experience share a short reflection on how you have seen God at work in/through you.
- You could share:
 - a reflection about your participation in an Immanuel ministry (or one story from an experience, event or activity).
 - how a sermon or learning opportunity has moved you to deeper faith and brought change in your life.
 - how God has been using you as you care/serve others in the community, state, country or world.
 - About a person who has impacted your faith life.
- Write as if you are talking to another person, i.e., using first person (“I” or “we”) language (Like writing a Facebook post).
- Limit your reflection to 250 words (you can write less).
- Allow time for multiple drafts as you edit your reflection down.
- Submit a photo to accompany your reflection or ask Martin to come and take a photo (We hope that the photo would be inviting, engaging and related to your reflection in some way).
