Tammy V: The funds that were in the building fund were put into CDs. Looking for more interest on them. Fall Clean up is November 6th- looking for volunteers. Trimming and leaves clean up. The baptismal font is leaking and there is a crack on the stone where the waterfall is. Met with a metal sculpture artist and he will be drawing up some ideas for a smaller baptismal font inside the larger one. Still looking to fill the Sunday custodial roll. Daryl is filling in for now. Please thank Daryl if you see him. Next capital campaign- what are the pieces? What is the scope? Roofing and HVAC needs to be fixed/replaced. Baptismal font? Technology in the sanctuary?

Kim: Benevolence for the building up campaign: Potential trip Winter 2022 (Feb/Mar) through Amextra in Mexico. Cost will run about \$2000 with airfare for a week. Ages 16 and up. It will be a hands-on trip- will include working on a farm, working with the children, etc. There is also reflection time and sight-seeing. One of our goals for the building up campaign was for sharing - \$40k was designated Amextra. The other \$10K was designated to Cristo in Shakopee.
