Program updates:

Fellowship: No updates at this time

Children's Ministries: Magician was livestreamed for Halloween for 30 families. Upcoming-Christmas Children's service- submit short videos for the service. Trying to get their 2021 budget out. Positive feed back about the new Sunday school program.

Worship/Music/Arts: Bell choir stated two weeks ago and working out well. Clark is interviewing for servant song, holiday music choices.

Properties: Great Fall clean up- Boyscouts and their families really showed up! Tom Totall blew out the water lines to the Disciples Garden.

Jody: No new updates Laura: we have \$61,000 in pledges for next year so far. Month of stewardship messages in November.

Lesly: Nothing new. Ran the dishwasher & Coffee pots to make sure they are still in working order. Suspect food in freezer will be thrown- please label or it will be purged.

Karen: Racial Justice Statement- General feedback from the listening sessions- overall, people were pleased and there are few minor things to change. Nice balance of feedback. Some were hung up on the word participation. Call to action vs statement. How do we continue in the weeks and months ahead? Uncomfortable is good- looking for more action statements, connecting back to faith.
