January Executive Minutes Immanuel Lutheran Church January 10, 2017

Beth called the meeting to order and gave devotions.

Secretary's report –Mike moved to approve, Scott seconded the motion.

Old Business:

2017 Budget status – we are \$30,000 behind budget (we needed \$200,000 in December). We considered three different scenarios, one with flat numbers, one with a 2-2.5% increase in giving, one with 3-4.5% increase. We also discussed various places for cuts, including benevolence and Camp Onamia where we are a member church (\$6,000), staff raises. We need a budget to present to the congregation at the annual meeting, so will discuss this with the council at large. Pledges are up this year by \$32,000 over last year, so some optimism is warranted. We could possibly move some one-time expenses into the capital campaign. The two truly impactful budget items are benevolence and staff salaries.

New Business:

Bylaws changes discussed- age of communion changed to parents' discretion, and the vice president will act as the long-range planning chair. To be discussed at the annual meeting.

Council elections- several people are needed to fill empty council positions.

Martin Rathjen presented a rough draft of Immanuel room use and technology fees. Martin will tweak the form as discussed, and submit a revised form to be approved via e-mail.
