Secretary's Report: Tony moved to approve, Bob seconded the motion, passed.

Planning is under way for Reformation celebration, Advent and Lent. Budget shows us about \$12,000 under right now, will address this in a letter and in the Give+ app, which is another option besides Simply Giving which accepts bank information and allows people to choose which fund their offering goes to, as well as any extra gifts people are inspired to give. Each giver can generate an individual giving report. The app eliminates the need for the discussed kiosk. The program can be accessed in 6 different ways. Gary Thrasher and Paul are talking with Servant Song about revamping the 11:00 service.

Planning for Susan's farewell party is under way, along with purchase of a special gift for her.

Saturday night worship is going well...25 or so on a regular basis.

Gary Thrasher would like to go down to 3/5 time and move Clark up to 2/5 time. Beth moved to approve, Bob seconded the motion, which passed. This will take effect October 16.

Susan Weaver's retirement, effective at the end of November, will necessitate change in our pastoral staff. Discussion continued about long-term planning for staffing and program, Tony asked for clarification of our goals and a document to that effect.

We discussed paying her to reflect her current level of commitment and the existing job description. Tony will research comparable positions in other churches.
