Pentecost Pinwheels

Materials

- copies of the pinwheel template (below)
- lightweight paper (regular printer paper works great!)
- crayons or markers
- scissors
- straight pins (tacks, pushpins, etc.)
- pencils with erasers.

Instructions

- 1. Cut out the square and decorate it on both sides.
- 2. Once the square is decorated, cut down the four lines towards the center.
- 3. Bend down (don't fold) every other corner and pin the tips together in the center.
- 4. Spin the pin in its hole a few times to help the pinwheel spin more freely.
- 5. Finally, stick the pin into a pencil eraser.
- 6. Blow on the front of the pinwheel and watch it spin!
