

Pentecost Pinwheels

Materials

- copies of the pinwheel template (below)
- lightweight paper (regular printer paper works great!)
- crayons or markers
- scissors
- straight pins (tacks, pushpins, etc.)
- pencils with erasers.

Instructions

1. Cut out the square and decorate it on both sides.
2. Once the square is decorated, cut down the four lines towards the center.
3. Bend down (don't fold) every other corner and pin the tips together in the center.
4. Spin the pin in its hole a few times to help the pinwheel spin more freely.
5. Finally, stick the pin into a pencil eraser.
6. Blow on the front of the pinwheel and watch it spin!
