## THINGS YOU SHOULD <u>NOT</u> DO IF YOU ARE IN A CAR ACCIDENT

**DO NOT** move the cars or injured persons until police and emergency personnel arrive, unless it would be dangerous to leave the cars and persons where they are.

**DO NOT** admit fault to the other driver or the police.

**DO NOT** allow anyone to leave the scene before the police arrive, but if they do, make sure you obtain as much information as you can about the other driver and vehicle.

**DO NOT** provide a statement to the other person's insurance company.



## THINGS YOU SHOULD DO IF YOU ARE IN A CAR ACCIDENT

- DO stay calm.
- **DO** notify police immediately, and cooperate with them at the scene. In a hit and run accident it is particularly important to report to the police immediately.
- DO make sure you tell the police if you believe you may have been injured.
- **DO** obtain all the detailed information regarding the accident like insurance information, policy numbers, names, phone numbers, addresses, etc.
- DO keep a record of all witnesses to the accident (Names, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses).
- DO notify your insurance company about the accident; even if it was not your fault.
- DO take photographs of your car if it has been damaged.
- DO see your own doctor or go to hospital immediately if you believe you have been injured.
- DO keep your current insurance information and this checklist with you in your vehicle.
